- 1977 – The U.S. State Department lifts its ban on gay and lesbian employees.
- 1978 – Oklahoma passes a “Teacher Fitness” statute, allowing local school boards to fire any teacher who “advocates, encourages or promotes homosexuality”.
- 1982 – Wisconsin becomes the first state to pass a gay civil rights law.
- 1990 – The U.S. Senate passes a bill that requires the federal government to compile statistics on hate crimes against gays and lesbians.
- 1991 – San Francisco becomes the first city to register same-sex domestic partners.

Driving Directions:

Take I-64 East to Exit 94 (Winchester/Van Meter Road). Bear to the right, go the stoplight and turn left onto US-60/Lexington Avenue.

Continue 1.5 miles (a few hundred feet past Winchester Cemetery) and turn right onto Hays Street. Go to the end of the street (only 2 blocks long) and turn left onto College Street.

You will see a large park on your right. Go to the end of the park and turn right onto Wheeler Avenue. You will see College Park Gym and Swim Complex on your left. 23 Wheeler Avenue is next door (it's a 2½ story stone house).

There is plenty of street parking. Please use the entrance on the right side of the house under the carpet. No need to knock; just come right in.
